Video Driver Issues

Te-waza of Karate-jutsu

The **Te-waza of Karate-jutsu CD-ROM** requires 100-percent Microsoft certified Video Drivers. If the video drivers you have are not certified, certain pages on this CD will appear to lock-up the computer. In reality all that is happening is that the mouse will not move (or will move VERY slowly) on pages with heavy text.

Here are some solutions:

- 1) On the Disclaimer screen at the beginning of program, use the TAB key on the keyboard to highlight the "AGREE" button then hit the spacebar. This will start the Main Menu.
- 2) On the "ABOUT THE AUTHOR" and "HISTORY" section, patience will be required. If you are exploring these pages you will have to wait until the cursor can catch up with the mouse movements.
- 3) These problems do not occur with 100-percent Microsoft certified drivers. ATI and Diamond Multimedia video drivers display this problem more than other card manufactures. We have found that installing older drivers or certified (rather than newer non-certified drivers), this problem disappears.
